INQUIRY AGENTS AND SECURITY GUARDS REGULATIONS

S.I. 45/1977

(SECTION 17)

[Commencement 7th July, 1977]

- 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Inquiry Agents and Security Guards Citation. Regulations.
 - 2. In these Regulations, unless the context other-wise requires-

Interpretation.

"the Act" means the Inquiry Agents and Security Guards Act;

"form" means a form prescribed in the First Schedule.

- **3.** (1) The forms set out in the First Schedule shall be used for the purpose of the Act with such variations as the circumstances of the case may require.
 - (2) The following are the forms set out in the First Schedule-
 - (a) Form 1, being the form of an application to engage in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards.
 - (b) Form 2, being the form of an application to act as an inquiry agent or security guard;
 - (c) Form 3, being the form of licence to engage in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards, or to act as an inquiry agent or security guard:
 - (d) Form 4, being the form of record to be kept by a person engaged in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards of the employment of such of his employees as are licensed to act as inquiry agents or security guards.
 - 4. (1) No licence issued under the Act shall be of any effect unless it is signed-

Licences: general provisions.

- in the case where the licensee is an individual, by the Minister and the individual;
- (b) in the case where the licensee is a body corporate, by the Minister and a director, manager, secretary or similar officer of the body corporate.
- (2) Applications for a licence shall be made at the office of the Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Home Affairs in such manner as the Minister may determine.
- (3) No licence shall be issued or renewed until the appropriate fee therefor set out in the Second Schedule has first been paid.
- (4) A licence may be renewed or varied by an endorsement thereon to that effect stating the period of the renewal or, as the case may be, the nature of the variation and such endorsement may be signed by the Minister.
- **5.** (1) Where the person making application for a licence to engage in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards is a body corporate such application shall be made on behalf of the body corporate by a director, manager, secretary or other similar officer thereof.

Licences to engage business of providing inquiry agents or security

(2) A licence to engage in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards. guards shall be granted or renewed subject to the following conditions (whether or not in addition to any other conditions)-

- the licensee shall not use the word "police" in connection with any of the activities of his business or to the employees of the licensee.
- (b) the dress of the employees of the licensee shall not resemble that of the Royal Bahamas Police Force either in colour or styling;
- security guards employed by the licensee shall not wear any uniform (c) other than a uniform which has been approved in writing by the Minister.
- 6. An application for a person to act as an inquiry agent or security guard shall be Licence to act as accompanied by two photographs of the applicant measuring not less than 1¹/₈" by $1^{1}/8$ " or more than $1\frac{1}{2}$ " by $1\frac{1}{2}$ ".

7. (1) The badge which security guards are required to wear under the provisions Badges. of subsection (2) of section 13 of the Act shall be of such design as the Minister may approve and the Minister shall not so approve a badge unless it conforms to the following requirements-

- the minimum size shall be 2" by 2"; (a)
- (b) it shall be of a distinctive colour;
- it shall bear a legend indicating that its wearer is a security guard.
- (2) A security guard shall wear his badge upon his cap or chest in such a manner that it is clearly visible in its entirety to other persons at all times while he is on duty.
- 8. (1) The holder of a licence to engage in the business of providing inquiry Records. agents or security guards shall keep a record of the employment of such of his employees as are licensed to act as inquiry agents or security guards in Form 4 and such record shall contain the particulars required by that Form.

- (2) The particulars required by Form 4 (other than the statement as to the date and time of termination of employment) shall be entered as soon as practicable after the date and time the particular employment commenced.
- (3) As soon as practicable after the termination of the employment the employer shall enter in the record the date and time of termination of employment and certify the record as being correct. The employee shall sign the record.
- (4) The record kept under this regulation shall be maintained at the principal place of business of the licensee and shall be available for inspection by any police officer at all reasonable hours.
- (5) In this regulation "employment" means a particular task or assignment performed outside the place of business of the employer.
- 9. There shall be paid to the Treasurer upon the grant or renewal of a licence Fees. under the Act the fees specified in the Second Schedule.

- 6. The holder of this licence shall not engage in the business of providing inquiry agents or security guards in a name other than that in which he is licensed.
